Relief



4,234

Compassion partner churches were severely affected by the storm. They need help to repair and rebuild their classrooms, kitchens and washrooms.

Many adults in affected areas are palm oil farmers. The crops are devastated and will not be fruitful for up to five years. These families of Compassion children will need income generating support.
